Chair Dougherty announced the start of the Board's five year rule review of OAR 438-007-0045. This rule pertains to the translation of documents and was triggered by *Camacho v. SAIF* in 2018. The Board has been asked to answer these five questions: (1) Did the rule achieve its intended effect? (2) Was the anticipated fiscal impact of the rule underestimated or overestimated? (3) Have any subsequent changes in the law required that the rule be repealed or amended? (4) Is there continued need for the rule? (5) What impacts has the rule had on small business? Though there is no specific process that is mandated for this rule review, WCB plans

to send out inquiries to the public and the advisory committee. Today, the Board is starting our inquiries and asking for public comment and feedback.
