Claimant, *pro se*, requests review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Davis' order that dismissed claimant's hearing requests regarding denials of his right wrist, arm, and shoulder conditions issued by Liberty Northwest Insurance Corporation (Liberty), Wausau Insurance Companies (Wausau), and Royal and SunAlliance (SunAlliance). On review, the issue is the propriety of the ALJ's dismissal order.

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order with the following supplementation.

By letter dated August 27, 2001, claimant's then-attorney withdrew claimant's requests for hearing regarding his claims with Liberty, Wausau, and Royal and SunAlliance. Pursuant to that written request, on September 26, 2001, the ALJ issued an order dismissing those hearing requests. On October 7, 2001, on his own behalf, claimant requested review of the ALJ's dismissal order, contending that the "decision was made unjustly."

Although disagreeing with the dismissal order, claimant makes no argument as to why that order was not appropriate. Specifically, claimant does not contend that his then-attorney was without authority to act on his behalf in withdrawing the hearing requests. Under these circumstances, we find no reason to alter the dismissal order.

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated September 26, 2001 is affirmed.
