On November 4, 2011, the Board found that claimant's diagnostic medical services claim for a left shoulder condition was compensable. The SAIF Corporation seeks reconsideration, asserting that the Board's decision regarding the diagnostic services conflicts with another portion of its decision (which upheld SAIF's denials of claimant's current left shoulder condition and need for medical treatment) and that the medical opinion on which the Board was internally contradictory.

To further consider this matter, the Board's November 4 order is withdrawn. Claimant is granted an opportunity to respond. To be considered, that response must be filed within 14 days from the date of this order. Thereafter, the Board will proceed with its reconsideration.
