Claimant requests review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Otto's order that: (1) upheld Adecco, Inc.'s (Adecco's) compensability and responsibility denials of her new/omitted medical condition claim¹ for bilateral deQuervain's tenosynovitis; (2) upheld the compensability and responsibility denial from the SAIF Corporation, on behalf of Robert Breitenstein (SAIF/Breitenstein) for the same condition; and (3) declined to award an assessed attorney fee under ORS 656.386(1) or ORS 656.308(2)(d). On review, the issues are compensability, responsibility, and attorney fees.

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order.

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated January 17, 2014, as reconsidered on February 19, 2014, and March 31, 2014, is affirmed.
