ORDER DISAPPROVING CLAIM DISPOSITION AGREEMENT

On June 3, 2016, the Board received the parties' Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA). We disapprove the proposed disposition.

A CDA shall not be approved if, within 30 days of submitting the CDA to us, the worker, insurer or self-insured employer requests that we disapprove it. ORS 656.236(1)(a)(C). Submission of the CDA is deemed to be the date of "filing" under OAR 438-005-0046(1)(a) and (d). OAR 438-009-0025(1), (2).

Here, the CDA was submitted to us on June 3, 2016. Claimant, *pro se*,¹ filed her request for disapproval of the disposition on June 20, 2016.² Accordingly, we disapprove the disposition. *Id.*

Inasmuch as the proposed CDA has been disapproved, the insurer or self-insured employer shall recommence payment of any temporary or permanent disability that was previously stayed. OAR 436-060-0150(5)(k) and (7)(e).

IT IS SO ORDERED.
