Claimant requested review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Bethlahmy's order that upheld the SAIF Corporation's denials of her occupational disease and new/omitted medical condition claims for complex regional pain syndrome (CRPS). The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" that is designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them that are pending Board review and before the Hearings Division (WCB Case No. 16-00865). Those portions of the agreement that pertain to issues pending before the Hearings Division have received ALJ approval.

Pursuant to those portions of the settlement that pertain to these cases, claimant understands that SAIF's denials, as supplemented in the agreement, "shall remain in full force and effect." Claimant further agrees that "the Request for Hearing shall be dismissed with prejudice."

By this order, we approve the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
