Claimant, *pro se*,¹ requests review of Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Poland's order that: (1) upheld Sedgwick Claim Management's denials of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for lumbar sprain/strain, sciatic neuralgia, and an L3-4 disc condition; (2) upheld Sedgwick's denial of claimant's occupational disease claim for a low back condition; and (3) declined to award penalties and attorney fees for allegedly unreasonable claim processing. On review, the issues are compensability, penalties, and attorney fees.

We adopt and affirm the ALJ's order.

ORDER

The ALJ's order dated September 28, 2015, as reconsidered December 23, 2015, is affirmed.
