On February 24, 2016, we affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order regarding claimant's whole person permanent impairment award for a bilateral carpal tunnel syndrome condition. It has come to our attention that the opening paragraph of our order contains a clerical error. Specifically, our order states that the ALJ's order reduced an Order on Reconsideration's whole person permanent impairment award of 34 percent to 4 percent. However, the ALJ's order actually affirmed the Order on Reconsideration, which had reduced claimant's 34 percent permanent impairment award to 4 percent.

To correct this oversight, we withdraw our February 24 order. As corrected above, we republish our February 24 order. The parties' 30-day appeal rights shall begin to run from the date of this order.
