On December 20, 2016, as reconsidered on January 19, 2017, and February 17, 2017, we issued an order that: (1) declined to award additional temporary disability benefits; and (2) awarded a penalty and penalty-related attorney fee under ORS 656.262(11)(a). The SAIF Corporation petitioned the court for judicial review of that order. The parties have since submitted a proposed Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), which is designed to release all of claimant's past, present, and future "non-medical service-related" benefits (including temporary disability, penalties, and attorney fees) concerning his February 2013 claim. The CDA further provides that, on its approval, the pending case before the court "shall be dismissed."

We have approved the CDA.<sup>1</sup> As a result of our CDA approval, the temporary disability, penalty, and attorney fee issues arising from this case are no longer viable.

Under such circumstances, and in accordance with the aforementioned CDA provision, this matter is dismissed.

**IT IS SO ORDERED.**
