On March 9, 2017, we issued an order that reversed an Administrative Law Judge's order that had affirmed an Order on Reconsideration that did not award work disability for a left ankle condition. The SAIF Corporation petitioned for judicial review. The parties have now submitted a Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), in which claimant has released all of her "non-medical service related" rights to compensation (including permanent disability) related to her April 2013 injury. The agreement also provides that, on its approval, this matter shall be dismissed. We have approved the CDA.

Under such circumstances, the issues pending in this case are no longer viable. Accordingly, consistent with our authority under ORS 656.298(9)(a), this matter is dismissed.¹
