On March 6, 2017, the Board issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that set aside the self-insured employer's denials of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claims for left and right medial meniscus tears. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Stipulation," which is designed to resolve the parties' disputes pending before the Court of Appeals and the Hearing Division. We are authorized to consider those portions of the agreement that pertain to matters pending before the court. ORS 656.298(9); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008). Those portions of the stipulation that pertain to issues pending before the Hearings Division have received ALJ approval. (WCB Case Nos. 16-03270; 16-03572).

Pursuant to those portions of the stipulation that pertain to the issues pending before the court, the employer agrees to withdraw its petition for judicial review and to pay claimant's counsel an additional employer-paid attorney fee. The stipulation further provides that the employer will accept and process the aforementioned new/omitted medical condition claims.

This date, we have approved those portions of the parties' stipulation that concern issues pending before the court, thereby fully resolving their dispute. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
