On March 10, 2017, we reversed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that had upheld the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's injury claim for a low back condition. Contending that we erred in determining that the "medical causation" issue regarding claimant's injury claim was not medically complex, the employer seeks reconsideration of our decision and reinstatement of its denial.

After considering the employer's contention, we conclude that our previous decision adequately articulates the basis for our decision. Consequently, we have nothing further to add to our previously expressed reasoning.

Accordingly, the employer's motion is denied. The parties' 30-day rights of appeal shall continue to run from the date of our March 10 order.
