On March 31, 2017, the Board affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that upheld the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's occupational disease claim for a bilateral shoulder condition. Contending that the Board order erred in finding Dr. Puziss's opinion was insufficient to establish that work activities were the major cause of her claimed bilateral shoulder condition, claimant seeks reconsideration of the decision.

After considering claimant's contentions, we conclude that the previous order, which adopted and affirmed the ALJ's order with supplementation, has sufficiently addressed the basis for the Board's decision. Consequently, we have nothing further to add to the previously expressed reasoning.

Accordingly, claimant's motion is denied. The parties' 30-day rights of appeal shall continue to run from the date of the Board's March 31, 2017 order.
