On August 1, 2017, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that declined to award penalties and related attorney fees for the SAIF Corporation's allegedly unreasonable claim processing. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have since submitted a proposed Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), in which claimant fully released his past, present, and future rights to "non-medical service" benefits (including penalties and attorney fees) for his June 2013 injury.<sup>1</sup>

We have approved the CDA. As a result of our CDA approval, the issues arising from our order are no longer viable. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
