On May 31, 2018, the Board issued an order that reversed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that upheld the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's injury claim for a right shoulder condition. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of that order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS) that is designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve their dispute pending before the Court of Appeals, in lieu of all prior orders. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the settlement, the parties agree that "all issues pertaining to the compensability of claimant's denied conditions and current need for treatment" are resolved. In addition, claimant understands that the employer's denial "shall remain in full force and effect."

We have approved the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
