On August 9, 2017, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that affirmed an Order on Reconsideration that awarded 4 percent whole person permanent impairment for claimant's lumbosacral back conditions. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have since submitted a proposed Claim Disposition Agreement (CDA), which is designed to release all of claimant's past, present, and future "non-medical service-related" benefits (including permanent disability) concerning his May 2014 claim.

We have approved the CDA.¹ As a result of our CDA approval, the issues arising from our order are no longer viable. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
