On May 31, 2018, the Board issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that upheld the insurer's denial of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for a left lateral epicondylitis condition. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of that order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement Agreement" (DCS) that is designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the DCS, the parties agree that the insurer's denial, as supplemented by the agreement, "shall forever remain in full force and effect." The agreement further provides that the "Request for Hearing shall be dismissed with prejudice."

By this order, we approve the parties' DCS, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
