On May 31, 2018, the Board issued an order that reversed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that upheld the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for L5-S1 disc herniation. SAIF petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS), which is designed to resolve their dispute pending before the Court of Appeals, in lieu of all prior orders. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the settlement, the parties agree to "settle all issues raised or raisable at this time." The agreement further provides that SAIF's denial, as supplemented in the agreement, "shall remain in full force and effect."

We have approved the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
