On February 19, 2019, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that set aside the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's injury claim. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS) that is designed to resolve all issues raised between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve their dispute pending before the Court of Appeals, in lieu of all prior orders. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the settlement, claimant agrees that the employer's denial, as supplemented by the agreement, "shall remain in full force and effect." The settlement further provides that the "Request for Hearing shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We have approved the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
