On October 26, 2018, the Board issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that set aside the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's new/omitted medical condition claim for depression. SAIF petitioned the court for judicial review of that order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS) that is designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve their dispute pending before the Court of Appeals, in lieu of all prior orders. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the settlement, claimant understands that his right to benefits for this denied claim "would be extinguished." The agreement further provides that "all issues raised or raisable" between the parties have been settled.

By this order, we have approved the parties' agreement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
