On May 23, 2019, we issued an Order on Remand that set aside the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's new/omitted claim for thoracic disc bulge conditions. The employer petitioned for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Disputed Claim Settlement" (DCS) designed to resolve all issues raised or raisable between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals, in lieu of all prior orders. We are authorized to consider the parties' DCS. ORS 656.298(9)(a); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the settlement, the parties agree that the employer's denial, as amended by the settlement, "shall forever remain in full force and effect." The settlement further provides that claimant's hearing request "shall be dismissed with prejudice."

We have approved the parties' settlement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
