On May 3, 2019, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that: (1) found that claimant's injury claim for right knee conditions was timely filed; and (2) set aside the SAIF Corporation's denial of claimant's injury claim. SAIF petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Stipulation," which is designed to resolve the issues in this case that are pending before the Court of Appeals. We are authorized to consider the parties' agreement. ORS 656.298(9); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the stipulation, SAIF agrees to accept a right knee strain and meniscus tear. The parties further stipulate that SAIF shall pay the attorney fee awards granted by the ALJ's and Board orders. Finally, the stipulation provides that the request for hearing "is dismissed with prejudice."

By this order, we have approved the parties' stipulation, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
