On February 12, 2019, we issued an order that reversed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that upheld the self-insured employer's denial of claimant's combined left foot condition. The employer petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Stipulated Settlement" designed to resolve all issues raised between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals. We are authorized to consider the parties' agreement. ORS 656.298(9); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the stipulation, the parties agree that the employer withdraws its petition for judicial review. Moreover, the parties agree that claimant's attorney is entitled to a reasonable attorney fee consistent with that granted by the Board order. Finally, the parties stipulate that this matter shall be dismissed "with prejudice."

By this order, we have approved the parties' agreement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
