On December 13, 2016, we issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that affirmed an Order on Reconsideration that awarded 9 percent whole person permanent impairment for claimant's right shoulder conditions. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Stipulation" designed to resolve all issues raised between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals. We are authorized to consider the parties' agreement. ORS 656.298(9); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the stipulation, the parties agree that claimant shall receive an additional award of 3 percent whole person permanent impairment, for a total of 12 percent whole person permanent impairment for her right shoulder conditions. The stipulation further provides for an "out-of-compensation" attorney fee payable from this increased award. Finally, the parties stipulate that the pending case before the court will be dismissed.

By this order, we have approved the parties' agreement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed.
