On November 30, 2015, the Board issued an order that affirmed an Administrative Law Judge's (ALJ's) order that affirmed an Order on Reconsideration that awarded four percent whole person impairment for claimant's left leg condition. Claimant petitioned the court for judicial review of our order. The parties have submitted a proposed "Stipulation and Settlement" designed to resolve all issues raised between them. Specifically, the agreement is designed to resolve the parties' dispute pending before the Court of Appeals. We are authorized to consider the parties' agreement. ORS 656.298(9); *Rebecca E. Seelye*, 60 Van Natta 332 (2008).

Pursuant to the agreement, the parties agree that claimant is entitled to additional permanent disability benefits. The stipulation further provides for an "out-of-compensation" attorney fee payable from this increased award. Finally, the parties stipulate that claimant's "request(s) for hearing shall be dismissed with prejudice."

By this order, we have approved the parties' agreement, thereby fully and finally resolving their dispute, in lieu of all prior orders. Accordingly, this matter is dismissed with prejudice.
