## Anticipated timeline

The 2024 Oregon Energy Efficiency Specialty Code (OEESC) is based on the 2022 edition of the ASHRAE Standard 90.1, which was published Jan. 25, 2023. **Updates to this timeline will be denoted in red.**

	Oct. 17, 2023	<p><b>Construction Industry Energy Board review</b></p> <p>The Construction Industry Energy Board will review a draft OEESC based on the ASHRAE 90.1-2022 with necessary Oregon amendments.</p>
Rulemaking	March 20, 2024	<p><b>Public rulemaking hearing</b></p> <p>The division will hold a public meeting where interested parties can provide testimony about the proposed code provisions.</p>
