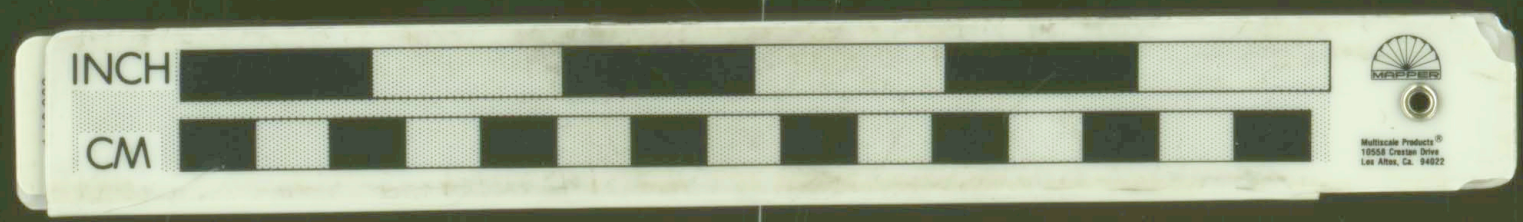


No ties were made to actual corners of the
