First let me thank you for the search for the missing map. I located it here after a frantic search so your efforts were in vain.

I am sending you colored ozilids of the Antelope and Malheur City areas, for your own use. They are rough as yet and will need some revision but are better than nothing.

Waters maps on the Post, Lookout Mt., Eagle Rock and Ochoco Res. quadrangles have been prepared. Todate I have only a preliminary copy of the Post quadrangle but should receive the others this winter. I will send you my copy of the Post quadrangle if you want to copy it. The original is at a scale of 1:31680 (or thereabouts) and I have simplified maps of the geology for use on the Oregon State Map at 1:96,000 and 1:250,000. State your desires. I do not know how soon the other quadrangles will come through.
