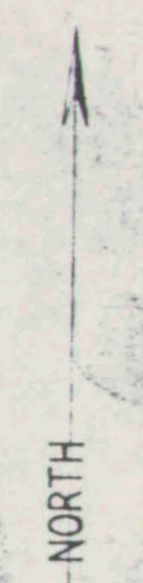


This Map was made by Philo H. Anderson, of Baker, Oregon, Prepared from the notes of a survey made by Philo H. Anderson and Henry L. Melton in November, 1927. All bearings are true bearings deflected from the true meridian as determined by a solar observation. Levels 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 as shown hereon, were placed on this map by superimposing maps of old workings and orienting by shaft and Old Station Tunnel. Instruments used: M. & L. E. Gurley Light Mountain Transit, 500 ft steel tape and clinometer. Elevations shown based on assumed Elev. of B.M. at Portal of New Cross-cut Tunnel as 6000.00'. Underground Elevations all determined by spirit leveling. Surface elevations determined by vertical angles and distance.
