This section shows the condition of the mine on Nov. 1, 1914, the end of our fiscal year.

This hanging wall cross cut has been advanced 225' from the drift. It has cut the dike and about 70' of granite and then cut a second dike parallel to the 1st dike and is now in the granite again. A slight vein was encountered between the two basalt dykes. No greenstone was seen in this cut.
