

A search was made of the available records pertaining to this survey. F measurements were made to locate the existing monuments shown here County Survey No. 9-37-11 shows the establishing of the C1/4 corner 32. Survey No. 9-37-46 dated June 1980, is a further subdivision of although a different position was established for the C1/4 corner of Se Survey No. 9-37-46 was performed for the Forest Service in order to National Forest Lands in Section 32. The narrative is a little vague in r procedure used to establish the E1/4 corner and the SE corner of this accept the monuments shown from Survey No. 9-37-46 for the subdiv section because of the adjoining National Forest Land.

The deed calls for the westerly line of the dredge area and gives cours line. I could not locate the survey which located the dredge area and p courses. Information from the Baker County Surveyor leads me to believe Woodwell, a surveyor from the early 1900's, produced these courses wh have used.
