## **RE:** Submittal of the Final Consolidated Permit Application, Grassy Mountain Mine Project

The Technical Review Team (TRT) unanimously accepted the Consolidated Permit Application (CPA) for the Grassy Mountain Mine Project as complete during the October 4, 2023, TRT public meeting. With the submittal of this CPA, DOGAMI will issue the Notice to Proceed starting the permitting phase (Phase 2) of the process.

This letter accompanies the submission of the final CPA dated October 9, 2023. This version of the CPA addresses all agency comments related to completeness as identified in DOGAMI's comment matrix. CPA changes are presented in Track-Changes that compares this version to the August 2023 revised CPA. The locations of the uploaded documents are listed below. The CPA was uploaded today to DOGAMI's file share system in a file called "CPA 20231009.zip."
