

MEMORANDUM

MIRIAM OIL COMPANY  
Bliven NO. 3  
Permit No. 29

I traveled to Dallas, Oregon on Wednesday morning March 19, 1958 to witness the abandonment of the Bliven No. 3 well. I was met at the well site by Mr. Thornhill.

Cement Plug (35'-50')

The hole was bailed out to 35 feet and a 5 sack slurry poured in the hole. Theoretical fill is 15.7 feet. The hole was then filled with mud from 50 feet to within 16 feet of the surface.

Cement Plug (3-13')

A 3 foot 4X4 was placed in the hole at 16 feet. Rubber discs (8" dia.) were nailed to the top and bottom of the 4X4. A 2 sack cement slurry was pured in on top of the 4X4 filling the hole to within 3 feet of the surface.

The casing was cut off 3 feet below the ground surface and a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " steel plate welded over the casing stub.
