Fragments of the following rocks were found in the drill cuttings circulated out of the hole while drilling from 1800-1824:

Sandstone

Medium - fine grained, tuffaceous, arkosic.

Light brown color, brittle.

Dark gray-black.

Volcanic ash

Cuttings contained a few very small pieces of ash.

A fragment of shell was found in one of the shale particles and resembled a portion of a Turritella(?).
