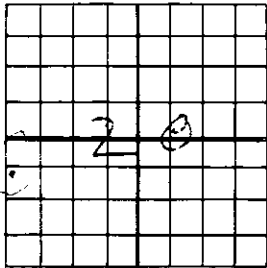


APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DRILL NEW WELL OR STRATIGRAPHIC HOLE
