PACCO MISSION

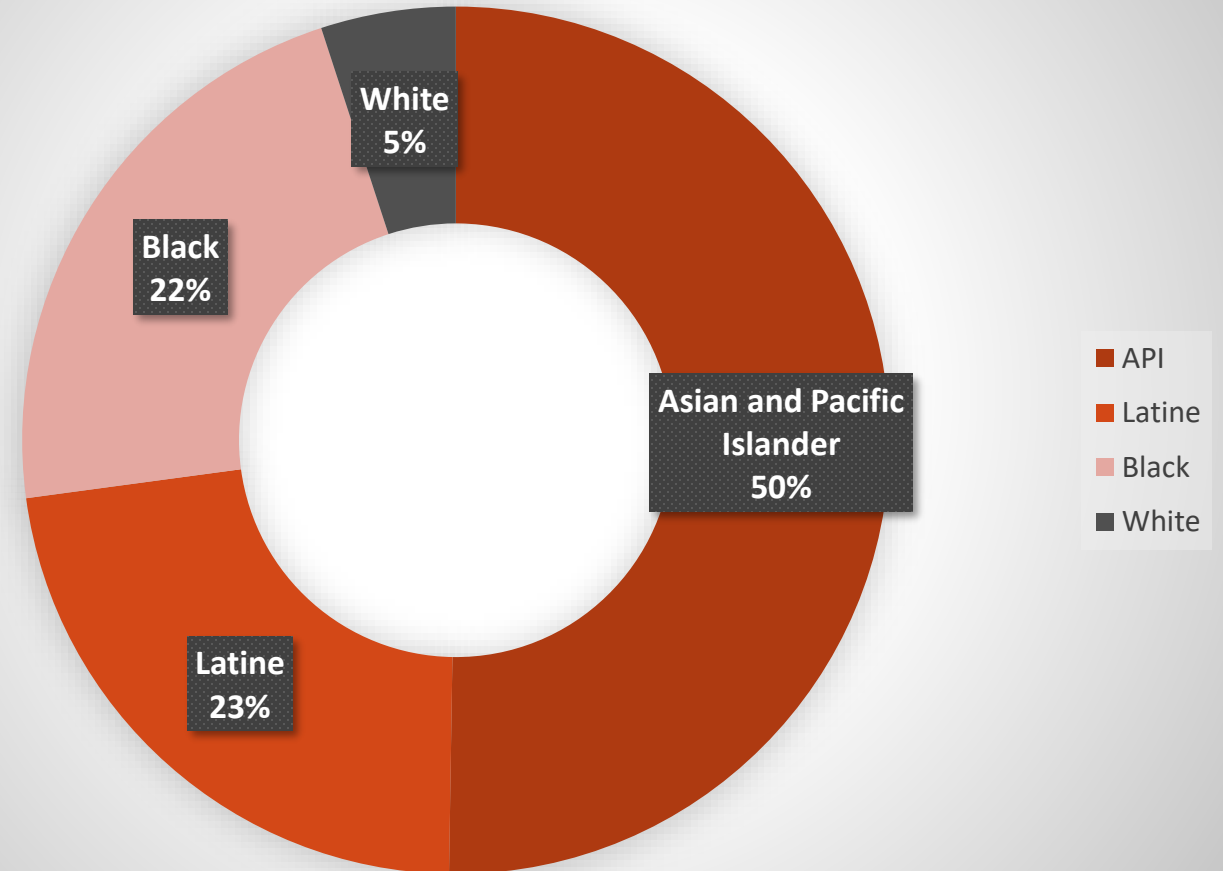
