Qualifiers:

- *Does not include programs that specify only Federal Lands.*
- *Does not include programs that would naturally fit under State agencies outside of SB 762 implementation agencies – such as watershed restoration programs through **OWEB** or wildlife habitat restoration programs through **ODFW**. These programs would also support wildfire resiliency across Oregon’s landscapes.*
- *Does not include programs under: National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. However, there may be a nexus with the State’s Wildfire Detection Camera system coordinated through ODF/University of Oregon?*
