

Common Course Numbering (CCN) Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) Subcommittee Charge

I. Purpose and Charge

Draft Common Course Numbering Oregon Administrative Rules for the Transfer Council to recommend to the full HECC Commission.

II. Background and Context

Under Senate Bill 233 (2021) the Transfer Council is tasked recommending Common Course Numbering rules to the Commission.

- The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall by rule establish the common course numbering system described in section 1 of this 2021 Act no later than September 1, 2024 (Section 4 (2))
- The Transfer Council established under section 6 of this 2021 Act shall: (a) Advise the Higher Education Coordinating Commission on the development, coordination and maintenance of the common course numbering system described in section 1 of this 2021 Act; ...(A) Establish and maintain the common course numbering system described in section 1 of this 2021 Act; (section 8 (1) and (1) (A))

III. Authorities and Responsibilities

The CCN OAR Subcommittee is responsible for drafting Transfer Council recommendations for CCN OARs to the full HECC Commission.

IV. Governance and Policies

For a subcommittee established under this subsection that will not make recommendations to the council on a subject that will be submitted by the council to the commission under section 8 (1)(d)(A) to (D) of this 2021 Act, the council may appoint any individual employed by a public university listed in ORS 352.002 or a community college operated under ORS chapter 341, including faculty, registrars, academic advisors and academic administrators. *Section 6 (c)*

V. Timeline

The Transfer Council will need to make their CCN OAR recommendation to the Commission by February 2024.
