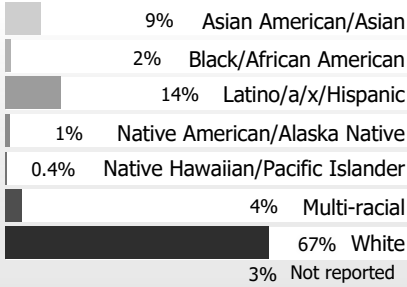

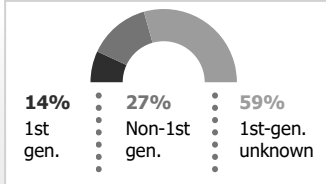
### Race/Ethnicity



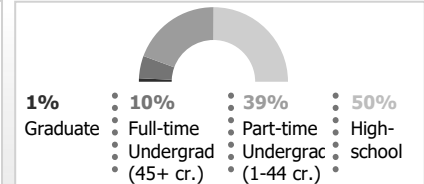
Students of color are increasingly represented on campuses. Currently, nearly **30%** of students identify as students of color.

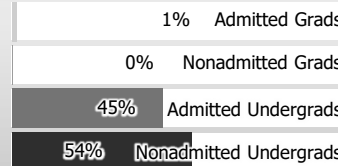
### 1st-Generation Status



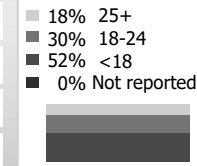
### Enrollment Level



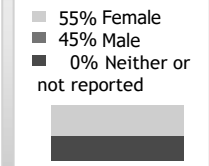
### Primary Area of Instruction (most credits)

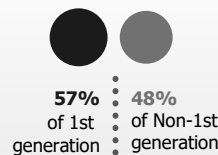
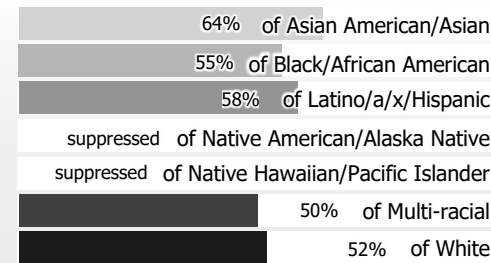

### Unable to Meet College Expenses with Expected Resources



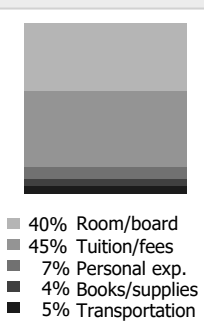

### Longer Time to Completion Increases Cost



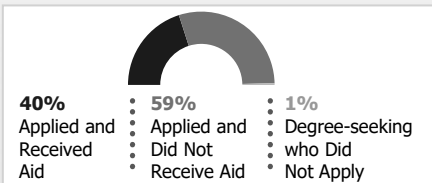

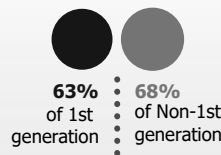
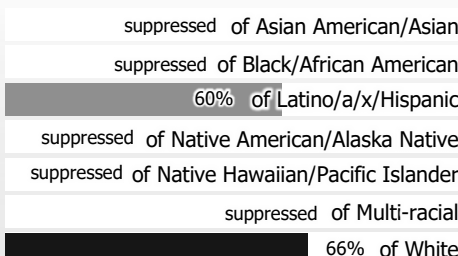
Loans fill the gap - **29%** of undergraduates have federal loans. Graduation rates rise with grants and fall with loans.
