

# COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS ODE Procurement Protocol

- All RFAs must be reviewed by, and award decisions discussed with, Director or Assistant Superintendent
- The Equity Lens will be followed for all funding decisions
- All RFAs must be reviewed by the Equity Team
- All RFAs must be reviewed by the Government and Legal Affairs Team
- All grant administrators must work with Procurement staff and fiscal analysts to meet necessary duties for financial administration
- All respondents must have at least 4 weeks to respond to an RFA
- Any grant review team cannot be fewer than 3 readers
- Grant reviewers will utilize a clear and consistent scoring rubric.
- Grant reviewers must have 25% or more participation from non-ODE staff
- Divisions must host technical assistance webinars

# COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS Youth & Community Grant Fund

#### Overview of applications

- 90 applications across all 3 Youth & Community tiers of funding
- Youth & Community application requests total \$18, 470,939
- Applications cover 51 different cities, 26 counties, and 6 Federally Recognized Tribes
  - Some applications are regional applications and service areas may include additional jurisdictional boundaries

# COMMUNITY INVESTMENTS Youth & Innovation Grant Fund

#### Overview of applications

- 31 Youth & Innovation applications
- Application requests total \$3,090,037
- Applications cover 10 counties, 13 cities and towns, and 3 Federally Recognized Tribes
  - Some applications are regional applications and service areas may include additional jurisdictional boundaries
