BACKGROUND	
In 2013, the State Board of Education adopted Smarter Balanced as Oregon's state assessments aligned to the Common Core State Standards in English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. During this briefing, ODE staff will provide information based on 2015-16 state ELA and mathematics assessment results. These results represent the second operational year of the new assessments. Analysis will include an explanation of participation rates and comparisons of student group performance. In addition, ODE staff will discuss patterns and trends in the data over the first two years of the new assessments. Lastly, ODE staff will provide information about similarities and differences observed in achievement gaps based on the new tests.
