**FINDINGS OF FACT**


(1) On April 15, 2011, parent filed a request for a due process hearing with the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

(2) A telephone pre-hearing conference was held on May 23, 2011. Attorney Lana Traynor represented parent. Attorney Connie Bull represented the Beaverton School District. The parties advised that they had reached a settlement but needed time to complete the paperwork. Another telephone pre-hearing conference was scheduled for June 6, 2011.

(3) On June 3, 2011, parent withdrew the request for hearing and requested that the case be dismissed with prejudice.

**ORDER**

The April 15, 2011 request for a due process hearing has been withdrawn and the case is dismissed with prejudice.
