BACKGROUND

On May 12, 2022, a grandparent filed a written complaint with the Oregon Department of Education regarding their grandchild's special education program in the Springfield School District. On July 21, 2022, the grandparent indicated that their complaint with the Springfield School District had been resolved and requested that their complaint be withdrawn.
