Lead Organization	Athena Weston School Dist.
Goal #1	By 2023 100% of freshman will be on track for graduation at the end of their freshman year
Short-Term Outcome	The 9th grade team will meet every two weeks. These team meetings will focus on data and alternate between looking at individual students in need of support and focusing on overall data to inform system changes and supports.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade freshman on track rate of 100% will be sustained.
Goal #2	By 2023 75% of students will earn 6 college credits though Dual credit, Eastern promise or Expanded options by graduation.
Short-Term Outcome	All students will meet with the Schools to Career advisor and Student Success Coordinator to help students to develop a pathway plan. Special attention will be given to traditionally underserved groups.
Long-Term Outcome	100% of students will identify one pathway to a career of interests.
Goal #3	By 2023 100% of students will be exposed to career and technical education programs and pathways.
Short-Term Outcome	All students will take one CTE class and visit a college campus that offers career and technical training programs.
Long-Term Outcome	WMHS will maintain that all students have the opportunity to exposor of CTE class and visit a college campus that offers career and technical training programs.
Goal #4	By 2023 95% of students will have regular attendance
Short-Term Outcome	Administration and attendance monitor coordinator will meet weekly to evaluate student attendance data.
Long-Term Outcome	WMHS will maintain attendance monitoring and intervention systems established during the 21-23 schoolyears.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The 9th grade team will meet monthly to evaluate freshman data. Current progress report will be used as a baseline to evaluate student performance. During the meeting teachers, behavior specialist, special education director (when needed) and administrator. Will share concerns, failures and success to help students to succeed where they are currently struggling. Attendance will also be verified during this meeting, by the attendance monitor. After the above have been discussed, intervention will be established and noted in a google doc..
