



## High School Success Plan 2021-2023



<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Central Curry SD</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	All students will leave 9th grade on track for graduation.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	<p>1. The school will offer summer school in 2021 and 2022 to provide credit retrieval courses and support.</p> <p>2. The school's Student Support Team will meet regularly with impacted students to provide academic, social and emotional support, assigning specific staff as mentors, to make up deficiencies as well as maintain current studies so not to deepen the deficit in credits. Support systems and exposure to advanced courses will be a focus at early middle school levels for focal student group populations including students with disabilities, Latino x/a/o, and students in poverty. The new teacher collaboration tracker and data system will be implemented in the 2021-22 school year.</p>
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	<p>1. The COVID pandemic has had a significant impact on students accessing school and having the regular academic, social and emotional supports to be successful. In comparison to this year's 71% rate of ninth graders on track, the previous year was 92%.</p> <p>2. The District is exploring the possibility of restructuring its schools by bringing the 7th and 8th grades to the current high school campus that will result in a 7-12 campus that will provide consistency in curriculum, instruction and support for the transition to high school. A renewed middle school-high school collaboration will take place to support the exposure to advanced course work at the 7th grade especially for focal student groups. 9th grade teachers will annually review 9th grade data to inform support systems. Empathy interviews are under consideration.</p>
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	1. Continue to offer an alternative education option for students who find challenges in attending the regular comprehensive high school.
