<b>Lead Organization</b>	<b>Central Linn High School</b>
<b>Goal #1</b>	Graduation Rates for 4-year cohort will increase to 80%
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	9/10 and 11/12 grade level teams meet monthly to track student progress and implement interventions for students. The CLOUD, an new alternative program will be an intervention for high mobility students and students of poverty who are significantly credit deficient in grades 10, 11, and 12.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	The 4-year cohort graduation rate will increase 17%.
<b>Goal #2</b>	Participation in dual credit courses will increase to 50% for 12th grade students.
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	Additional dual credit courses will be offered to to all students in grades 10-12. High mobility students, and students of poverty will be encouraged to participate in new and existing dual credit courses by the teachers of the courses, advisory teachers, and school counselor when students are selecting elective courses.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	Participation in dual credit courses of 12th grades students will increase 15%
<b>Goal #3</b>	Participation in CTE courses will increase by 30%
<b>Short-Term Outcome</b>	A third CTE program will be offered to all high school students. Current CTE programs (Agriculture and Health Services) will offer additional new courses.
<b>Long-Term Outcome</b>	The number of full CTE programs offered will increase from two to three programs.
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #1</b>	Vision Purpose Culture Team: This team is comprised of administration, licensed, and classified staff and the focus is to identify barriers students may face, seek opportunities for improvement, as well as create a safe and welcoming school for all learners.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 1
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #2</b>	Advancement Via Individual Determination: AVID is a parallel support program designed to provide critical skills to students who historically have been underserved by schools. For Central Linn, the focus groups including students who experience poverty and high mobility, are key in the work of the AVID team and strategies. This includes targeted support for courses as well as opportunities to explore post-secondary goals.
<b>Goal(s) this activity addresses</b>	Goal 1
<b>Dropout Prevention Activity #3</b>	Targeted intervention support: CLOUD. This series of courses offers structured and smaller support for students focusing on social-emotional needs, skill development, trained licensed and classified staff, and targeted support for students to succeed to graduation and beyond.
