Lead Organization **Elgin School District**

Goal #1	Students attending Elgin High School will improve their attendance rate by 10% during the first year of implementation. During the second year of implementation students will continue to improve attendance with a goal of another 5%.
Short-Term Outcome	Increased attendance should result in the opportunity to increase our student outcome in the classroom. We would plan on seeing 10% fewer students failing their on campus classes.
Long-Term Outcome	Increased attendance and additional course offerings will have the opportunity to increase student participation in all programs by 10% based on data collected in the 2020-2021 school year.
Goal #2	Elgin School District will work with the local ESD to support the alignment and implementation of dual credit opportunities, work place opportunities, and student placement. Students taking advanced courses will increase from 5% to 25% of students in advanced coursework.
Short-Term Outcome	All High School Seniors and Juniors will have the opportunity to secure college credited / dual credit courses through partnerships the District will establish and build with EOU, BMCC, TVCC, and other post secondary institutions.
Long-Term Outcome	25% of all High School Seniors and Juniors will increase their college level / dual credit courses by the end of the 24/25 school year.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Elgin School District will continue to offer online courses parallel to our on campus courses. Online students will receive support from trained staff and be invited to participate in activities and programs on campus. Budget will cover staff time for alternative ed instruction, as well as access to the online curriculum.
Goal(s) this activity addresses	Goal 1
College Level Opportunities Activity #1	Elgin School District will continue to work with the local ESD consortium on rebuilding College level opportunities for our students. The instructor in our ALT Ed position will support the implementation and direction of those activities and will coordinate the access, registration details of these online courses for students. This coordinator will monitor communication between colleges and classroom instructors on campus.
Goal(s) this activity addresses	Goal 2
Career Technical Education Activity #1	Elgin School District will implement an advanced technology class, tied to current Business and Management CTE POS. The purpose of this class will be to support student interns in learning the software and applications of recently purchased technology. It will be our intent to have student led productions and parent communications.
