Lead Organization	Harrisburg
Goal #1	To have over 90% of freshman on track to graduate each year.
Short-Term Outcome	Have our student success coach meet with all 9th graders and their families to develop individual goals and course pathways. Have our student success coach meet with our 9th grade PLC teams monthly to go over student data. Provide opportunities in the master schedule for 9th graders to take CTE courses
Long-Term Outcome	The have the number of 9th graders on-track to graduate at 90% or above.
Goal #2	Improve the transition of students from Middle school to High school.
Short-Term Outcome	Vertical alignment of English and Math curriculum will take place during designated PLC time monthly. All 8th grade students will have an individualized success plan that includes grades, attendance, behavior, and college/career aspirations. Students and families will also meet with our counselor or student success coach to go over course descriptions and pathways that are available in High School prior to Fall.
Long-Term Outcome	The number of Juniors that have a plan in place for post secondary opportunities (college/trades/career/military) will be at 75% or higher
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Maintaining newly established student resource center -Staff will collaborate with student success coach and counselor with an emphasis on students with disabilities, students experiencing poverty, and mobile students.
