Lead Organization	Knappa School District
Goal #1	90% of KHS students who experienced incomplete or failed credit due to CDL during the late 2019-20 school year and 2020-21 school year will be remedied.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers and support staff meet regularly to review student data and develop appropriate interventions and opportunities for students to earn missed credit. Administration ensures that necessary pathways are made available to earn missed credit.
Long-Term Outcome	KHS graduation rates will remain steady at > than 90% due to interventions ensuring missed credits are earned and students are able to graduate on time.
Goal #2	Participation in advanced courses and/or dual enrollment by underrepresented KHS student populations will increase by 20%.
Short-Term Outcome	Staff will continue to develop and add to the master schedule, advanced and dual enrollment courses relevant to student populations and their post high school goals. Staff will ensure that master schedule does not present conflicts to students wishing to take advanced and/or dual enrollment courses.
Long-Term Outcome	Overall participation rates by KHS students in advanced and/or dual enrollment courses will increase by 20% in the 2024-25 school year.
Goal #3	The number of KHS students considered chronically absent will decrease by 25%.
Short-Term Outcome	Staff will develop and implement SEL practices to ensure students feel safe, valued, and respected at KHS. Staff will monitor student engagement and academic success, providing intervention when needed. Students will be given opportunities of leadership and the ability to institute change.
Long-Term Outcome	There will be a 25% reduction in the number of KHS students who are chronically absent by the 2024-25 school year.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Continued support for 9th grade success team. The team meets twice monthly to discuss student needs and develop appropriate interventions. In addition to 9th grade staff, school counselor, and principal the team also includes up to two 9th grade and one 10th grade student who identify a relevant problem of practice and implement action steps.

Dropout Prevention Activity #2	9th grade orientation summer camp - incoming 9th grade students and parents will have an opportunity to participate in a three day summer camp designed to prepare them for high school. Students will meet teachers, participate in their daily schedule, Q & A with upper classmen, learn about clubs and co-curricular activities, and learn about themselves and each other through team building activities. Upper classmen will serve as mentors trained through the Boomerang Project's Link Crew.
