| Lead Organization | Lowell School District |
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| Goal #1 | 90% of 9th grade students will be on-track to graduate after completing their 9th grade year. |
| Short-Term Outcome | Teachers of 9th grade students will meet minimally once a month to review data including but not limited to grades, attendance, behavior, assessment. etc. Administration and/or the counselor will communicate with parents after each meeting. Parents will be directly involved if needed. |
| Long-Term Outcome | 95% of students will graduate with their 4 year cohort. |
| Goal #2 | Students taking advanced coursework will increase by 10%. |
| Short-Term Outcome | Students will be encouraged to attending Lane Community College in-person or online to take classes that are not offered at Lowell. |
| Long-Term Outcome | Lowell High School will increase the number of dual credit classes by 25%. Currently targeting Writing 122, Calculus, and Construction. |
| Goal #3 | 90% of all students will be determined to be regular attenders. |
| Short-Term Outcome | Administration, counselor, and staff (as needed) will meet monthly to review attendance data. Meetings will take place with students and parents to create plans to improve attendance. |
| Long-Term Outcome | 95% of students will be determined to be on-track for graduating with their 4 year cohort. |
| Goal #4 | 95% of students will graduate with their 4 year cohort. |
| Short-Term Outcome | Opportunities for credit recovery will be given during the school day. Before/After school classes/activities, online classes, and work experience will be offered to students can recover credits. |
| Long-Term Outcome | Students will graduate with a focus on post-secondary plans. All students will develop a post-secondary plan before graduating. |
| Goal #5 | Develop and enhance CTE courses to appeal to wider variety of students including underserved populations, students living in poverty, and students with learning disabilities. |
| Short-Term Outcome | Administration and staff will reach out to businesses and individuals in the community to increase their involvement with CTE programs/classes. |
| Long-Term Outcome | Student enrollment in CTE courses will increase by 10%. |
| Dropout Prevention Activity #1 | Students will meet with administration, the school counselor, and staff as needed. Tutoring and credit recovery classes will be offered to ensure that students graduate on time. Summer school will be offered to specific students who are determined to be not on-track for graduation. |
